Pierre Kuhn, MD, PhD, is a senior neonatologist and a professor of paediatrics at the University Hospitals of Strasbourg, France where he is the Head of the Neonatal Department.

Pierre conducts research in neonatology and developmental neuroscience also in the Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique. His work focus on the interactions between the early environment of NICUs and sensory system development, the impact of early life adversities in neurodevelopment, pain modulation in the broad topic of infant and family centered developmental care and on the evaluation of neonatal care & outcomes of preterm infants. Prof Kuhn is coordinating the Group of Reflection and Evaluation of the Environment of Newborn infant in France and is also the president of the Scientific Committee of the French Neonatal Society. In addition, he is the chair of the topic expert group on Infant and Family Centred Developmental Care of the European Foundation of the Care of Newborn Infant (EFCNI) Standard of Care for Newborn Infant.
